has improved significantly.
Frontiers is focused on

evangelizing two of the "least reached" people groups in Ghana: the Lobi and Wala people. They are experiencing tremendous results as the students plant new churches and preach the gospel throughout the region!

Crusades for Christ Bible Institute has twenty-two committed students, eager to grow in the knowledge of Christ. They will hold their second graduation this December!

There are now fifty-five churches/ministries who have affiliated with AABS! Our goal in 2006 is to have 100 Church-based Bible Schools.

Excerpts from John Piper, "Let The Nations Be Glad!"


Consider the amazing scope of prayer in the life of the early church. They called on God...


