FIVE ATTRIBUTES OF INSPIRATIONAL LEADERS

The Sahara plays tricks on the eyes of those traveling through it. To thirsty travelers, it appears as if an oasis is in the distance. However, as they journey on they realize it was only a

mirage—an appearance of water from a distance.

Unfortunately, there are many leaders who look impressive from a distance, but end up being disappointments. To restore our confidence in leaders they have to be able to inspire us, believe in us and help us to grow. How can we as leaders inspire others to follow?

1. ATTITUDE OF SERVICE

We must have an attitude of service toward those we are leading. When you serve, people are drawn to follow you because they know you will find ways to make them better people.

2. AFFIRMATION

We need to have a positive view of others. Leaders should search for the best traits in people and try to uncover them instead of fault-finding. Focusing on a person's strength inspires them by giving them confidence and self-worth.

3. ATTENTIVENESS

Great leaders know the desires of those under them. People don't really care how

much their leaders know, they want to know how much they care about them. When leaders attend to the needs of their team, the commitment of each team member deepens.

4. AVAILABILITY

Leaders inspire by investing time in the people they lead and by making themselves available. Leaders need to spend time with those under them, planned time, not just a conversation in passing. Nothing communicates that you value a person more than the gift of your time.

5. AUTHENTICITY

Leaders have to be genuine to inspire those around them. Followers want to trust their leaders. To gain trust, a leader must align words and deeds in their everyday lives. They also need to show a degree of transparency.
